The aim of the Call is to support scientifically excellent transnational **multidisciplinary** R&D&I projects in at least one of the following topics:

Enhancement of predictive breeding technologies and development of new genotypes leading to new phenotypes and crop varieties for improvement of plant health, protection, production and resilience

Development and exploitation of novel integrated pest and crop management methods and practices

Improvement of resource-use efficiency of crops and cropping systems

Systemic research on agricultural crops as part of an ecosystem including interactions between plants and other organisms (“the plant as a meta-organism”)

General eligibility criteria

- Consortia must include at least **three eligible partners** requesting funding from **three different SusCrop member countries**.
- Project duration must not exceed 3 years.
- Project outputs are expected to provide benefits to all partner countries.
- Consortia need to be balanced between countries both in terms of number of partners and distribution of work and budget.
- The requested funding budget of each partner must not exceed national or regional funding limits.

Eligible funding recipients

- Funding is provided according to the “nationality principle” and is subject to national/regional eligibility regulations.
- Partners from countries not participating in the Call may participate in a project at their own expense, if their contribution is important to achieve the project goals. Partners participating at their own expense are not counted into the minimum number of participants.
- The consortium coordinator must be employed by an organisation that is eligible by one of the agencies participating in the Call.
